TMC/Cedar Ridge High School Band Boosters reserves the right to limit the number of sponsors and may reject any sponsorship for any reason. TMC/Cedar Ridge High School Band Boosters reserves the right to refuse any sponsor that conflicts with the sponsorship public policies, RRISD policies or applicable law.
